As a head or assistant coach, I agree to uphold all rules and regulations regarding Golden Empire Youth Tackle Football & Cheer. I understand that if I violate these ethics, I can and will be suspended from practices for one week and the following week’s game. I understand that the Area Rep and Board of Directors will be contacted about my behavior and upon Board review may be removed from further league participation. If found to be in good standing, I will be allowed to return to league play.

If there is a second incident, (ejection from a game), the matter will be directed to the Board of Directors for automatic review.

In the event I’m involved in a third incident (ejection from game), there will be no board review and I can and will be removed from my coaching position.

I agree that I am empowered to actively recruit players within my own areas boundaries. Participants may not be involved in any GEYF and/or GEYC activity unless covered by insurance and have

signed an official league waiver/release of liability form, this includes get-togethers. I understand that the leagues intent is to place a player up in the age division which best represents his/her age and weight. I understand that if a player is over weight for game, he/she will not participate. I understand that it is my obligation to participate in all GEYF or GEYC coaching clinics and other community coaching clinics to help the betterment of the league. I am required to know all Federation High School and GEYF/GEYC Rules. Failure to abide by these rules, regulations, and modifications is just cause for removal.

Coaches Code of Conduct

Each area's coaching staff, under the direction of the Area Representative and head Varsity coach, shall be responsible for training and organizing each levels coaching staff. Any violations of the following ethics will result in an initial "warning". Each violation will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and may result in suspension or permanent expulsion from the league.

“Coaches will emphasize that athletes are good students and winning is the result of teamwork.”

Coaches will emphasize physical & mental conditioning of their participants as well as discipline and respect for authority. Coaches will accept decisions of officials as being fair and called to the best of the official's ability.

Coaches will not criticize participants in front of them members, parents or spectators.

Coaches will not instruct in such a manner that may jeopardize a participants health. Coaches will always abide by a medical attendants decision in all matters of injury.

Coaches will refrain from excessive sideline coaching.

Coaches will be responsible for the conduct and control of team fans and spectators.

Coaches will not use abusive/profane language.

Coaches will not "pile it on" as the phrase is used when a team gets a commanding lead and attempts to increase the score as high as it can. In

these instances, every effort will be made to allow each participant to participate.

Coaches will not permit an ineligible participant to participate in a practice, scrimmage or game.

Coaches will never instruct nor allow participantsto use any method or tactic that might cause excessive or deliberate punishment or abusive to any and all participants.
